MILWAUKEE – Milwaukee Public Library Director Joan Johnson has announced the appointment of Shelly Conley to serve as the library's Poet Laureate from 2025 to 2026.

Milwaukee native Shelly Conley has always had a Love for words. As a skilled writer, poet and all around creative, her listeners call her "gifted", "inspirational", "illustrator" and "amazing", to quote a few words. Her writing is reflective, forgiving and creates a call to action for the listeners. Shelly is a 7-time member of Milwaukee's National Poetry Slam Team. Her talent has led her to numerous poetry venues, community panels, artistic documentaries and musical collaborations with local and national talent.
